



Sixth form entry requirements



In order to secure a place at Woodrush Sixth form, student must have achieved a grade 5 or above in Math and both English Literature and English Language and meet the subject entry requirements below.

Art and Design	Grade '5' in Art
Biology	Triple Science: Grade 666 with a Grade 6 in Maths Double Science – Grade 66 with a Grade 6 in Maths Grade 7s preferred.
Business Studies	Grade '6' in English Language/Literature and Grade '6' in Maths
Chemistry	Triple Science: Grade 666 with a Grade 6 in Maths Double Science – Grade 66 with a Grade 6 in Maths Grade 7s preferred.
Computer Science	Humanities grade 6 or above and English literature/language grade 6 or above, minimum of grade 5 in the second English.
Drama Level 3 Diploma	Grade 6 or above or evidence of drama experience outside of school.
English Literature	Grade 6 in English Literature and English Language
English Language	Grade 6 or higher in English Language
Film Studies	Grade 5 in Film Studies or GCSE Grade 6 English Language or English Literature
Geography	Grade 5 in Geography and / or a Grade 6 in science, English and Maths
History	Grade 6 in History and Grade 6 in English
Maths	Grade 7 in Maths (Grade 6 maybe considered)
Music	Grade 6 in Music
PE	Grade 5 in PE. Student must also compete in a sport.
Physics	Triple Science: Grade 6666 - with a Grade 6 in Maths Double Science: Grade 66 with a Grade 7 in Maths Grade 7s preferred
Product Design	Grade 5 in a GCSE Technology subject
Psychology	Grade 6 in English Language and Grade 5 in Maths
Sociology	Grade 5 in English Language and English Literature and Grade 5 in humanities subject
Spanish	Grade 6 in Spanish

NB: In order for subjects to run a minimum number of students must be reached, if that number is not reached then students will be notified as soon as possible to consider alternatives. Once subjects are put into the school timetable if there are any subjects clashes and students can not take one of their options they will be notified as soon as possible to consider an alternative.
