Dear Parents/Carers,

A fantastic opportunity has been created for your child to take part in a residential trip to Weymouth, Dorset to support the History and Geography curriculum in Year 8. The trip will depart on Monday 14<sup>th</sup> July 2025 at 8:00 am and return on Wednesday 16<sup>th</sup> July 2025 at approximately 4:30 PM. The total cost of the trip will be £335.00 and will include:

- Transport to all venues in an executive coach
- Full Board meals provided (Monday evening to Wednesday lunchtime)
- 2 nights of accommodation at Osmington Bay PGL centre (near Weymouth)
- All excursions (to include):
  - Bovington Tank Museum
  - Commonwealth War Graves
  - Lulworth Cove Tour
  - Portland Tour
  - Portland 'Pirate' graveyard
  - Weymouth Harbour
  - Chesil Beach
  - 'Tubing' activity on dry ski slope
  - Evening team building activities led by PGL group leaders

If you would like to reserve a place for your child on this trip please pay a non-refundable deposit of £100.00 as soon as possible. We predict that demand for this trip will be very high and we only have a maximum of 58 places available. If the trip is oversubscribed then names will be 'drawn out of a hat'.

However, your child's place may be refused/refunded if your child is currently displaying significantly poor behaviour or does so prior to the departure of the trip; this will be at the discretion of the Head teacher.

A second payment of £100.00 will need to be paid by Friday 7<sup>th</sup> February 2025.

A third and final payment of £135.00 will need to be paid by Friday 4<sup>th</sup> April 2025.

As a result of additional funding direct from government, students in receipt of Free School Meals or Pupil Premium Students, are eligible for funding of 10% of the cost of this trip which will be automatically deducted on Parent Pay.
